"Strive for 5" reading challenge.

Reading Records include: Term dates for the year, year group
spellings, times tables and letter formation sheets
The weekly strive for 5 challenge is continuing with week 1
starting Friday 7th September. There is an individual box to
sign/comment in each time your child reads with an adult.
Staff will check and stamp reading sessions daily. There will
continue to be weekly rewards for achieving 'Strive for 5' and
half termly rewards. 'Get out of jail free' card (page 3). This
will be used the first time your child misses a week. Once used
you then have no further chances if you miss a week's Strive
for 5.
Strive for 5 really **DOES** make a difference to your child's
reading ability which is why this is a whole school initiative.
Staff will question children about the texts they have read.
Replacement books will cost £5.00.
