Summary of Pupil Premium Funding

Objectives in spending Pupil Premium Funding

- To raise pupil's academic ability in reading
- To improve Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar in KS2
- To develop pupil's self-esteem

Summary of spending and actions taken

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| - Part funding of STA to deliver 1-1 support | £ 7,583 |
| - Part funding of STA to support in KS2 classes | £ 4,375 |
| - Part funding of STA to deliver 1-1 support and small group work to develop Social and Emotional Aspects of Learning | £10,792 |

Impact

The impact was observable through:

- Significant progress in reading of between 1 year 2 months and 3 years 6 months being made by the targeted pupils
- Significant progress in reading, writing and maths. All targeted pupils making at least expected progress and 85% making greater than expected progress.
- KS2 results significantly improved on 2014 results in Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar from 39% L4+ and 39% L5+ to 93% L4+ and 64% L5+
- KS2 results significantly improved on 2014 results in Maths from 69% L4+ and 15% L5+ to 83% L4+ and 64% L5+
- Level 6 was achieved by 15% L6 Writing, 7% L6 Maths
- 1-1 support enabled a child to work within school with their peers engaging fully with the curriculum and social aspect of school life.
- Small group SEAL activities fully engaged pupils in need of building self-confidence and social awareness skills in a range of group activities. Pupils developed an understanding of team work and ability to communicate more easily with their peers.
