Impact

The impact was observable through:

Pupils who participated in the Closing the Gap literacy project delivered by the apprentice TA/TA. All pupils Reading Ages improved, as did their Comprehension Age:

Reading Age

- 6/7 made more than the 5 months progress from January to May.
- 1 pupil made 1 year 8 months progress
- 1 pupil made 2 years 4 months progress

Comprehension Age

- All pupils made at least 1 year progress
- 1 pupil made 2 years 5 months progress
- 1 pupil made 4 years 9 months progress

1-1 teacher supported pupils

- 1 pupil made 14 APS in maths from June 12-June13
- 1 pupil made 10 APS in maths from June 12-June 13
- 1 pupil on track to make 6 APS from June 12-June 13 but left just prior to SATs
- 1 pupil made 6 APS in maths from June 12-June13

Small group maths class

- 5/6 pupils made 4 APS Year 1 Year 2
