## Derwent Vale Teaching and Learning expectations during National Lockdown

Dear Parents/Carers,

Following the latest lock down announcement we have moved teaching for all pupils to online delivery.

Aim:

To continue to engage pupils in learning

To enable access to online set work, recorded and live video links

To build high expectations of engagement and quality of work produced

I would like to outline the work you should expect to find on Showbie or Tapestry for EYFS and the school expectations of pupils on a daily basis.

Teachers will set work which can be accessed between 8.45am and 4.00pm. After 4.00pm pupils will no longer be able to access the days tasks. This is to ensure work is completed daily during the working school day.

Work will be marked on the day between 8.45am and 4.00pm.

EYFS

A range of activities and suggestions will be uploaded on to Tapestry for you to do with your child. Photographs or short videos can be uploaded by parents to show us how brilliantly your child is doing.

Reception children will also find phonics activities to be completed daily.

Year 1

Each day staff will upload Read Write Inc sessions to be completed with your child. These are essential to keep up the good progress your child has been making this school year.

Each day class teachers will upload a maths lesson and task following our whole school No Problem maths scheme.

Each day there will be a task set around the topic the class are currently studying. Knowledge notes and Curriculum Visions texts; which your child has become familiar with in school and has used a lot, will support this learning.

Year 2 to Y6

Each day class teachers will upload a literacy task.

During the week this will cover a reading comprehension, 2 tasks which focus on spelling and grammar and 2 tasks from a range of activities.

Each day class teachers will upload a maths lesson and task following our whole school No Problem maths scheme.

Each day there will be a task set around the topic the class are currently studying. Knowledge notes and Curriculum Visions texts; which your child has become familiar with in school and has used a lot, will support this learning.

All pupils Y1 – Y6 should be reading 5 times a week and recording this as their Strive for 5. Pupils will have access to the usual apps of TT Rockstars, Lexia.

We understand that some children may not have access to a suitable electronic device. If this is the case please contact school for support.



**Achieving Together**



Unlike the last lock down the government has made online learning mandatory for all pupils. We have tried to ensure tasks are clear and accessible.

By setting daily tasks we hope to support you in getting your child to engage in their learning regularly, on a daily basis. Class teachers will be able to see immediately who is completing the work and will be contacting those who do not engage.
