#### Street Tag

We are excited to be taking part in the Street Tag Cumbria Schools Leaderboard program.

With Street Tag, children and families record the distance they walk, run, or cycle by collecting virtual tags with their smartphone at various locations, watching their total distance add up to climb up the Schools leaderboard; steps are converted into points by syncing their steps into the Street Tag app. This is designed to encourage families to walk and cycle to school, to be physically active, to connect with green spaces, and is an opportunity to rediscover our local area as well as earn rewards for our school.
